Learned counsel for petitioners submits that the petitioners have filed this petition seeking protection of their life and liberty alleging that they are major and have married against the wishes of the respondents Nos.4 and 5, who are parents of petitioner No.1. The date of birth of the petitioner No.1 is 27.12.1999 as shown in Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) and that of the petitioner No.2 is 16.09.1998 as shown in Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2). Apprehending danger to their life and liberty, they moved representation dated 09.01.2018 (Annexure P-4) to Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad. He confines to the relief claimed in this petition for direction to the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to look into the said representation of the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

In view of the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to look into the

representation dated 09.01.2018 (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of copy of this order along with representation in his/her office. In the meanwhile, the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad is directed to ensure protection of life, limb and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect with regard to the validity of marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
