The petitioner has filed third petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.111, dated 31.10.2016 registered under Sections 302, 341, 148, 149, 120-B of IPC (Section 201 IPC and Sections 27, 54 & 59 of Arms Act were added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This Court did not accede to the request for grant of regular bail on earlier occasions because the evidence of the material witnesses was not recorded. Now the evidence of the witnesses has been recorded. I have gone through the evidence of the material witnesses, that has been produced on record. The attribution to the petitioner is that he was carrying the rifle and standing nearby bus stand to help other persons. Prima facie, the case is made out for grant of bail.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-7420 OF 2018 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.
