Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for direction to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.5, who is a financier and is making an attempt to forcibly take away the vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No.PB-46-M-6772 with the help of recovery agents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from his client Sukhdev Singh, who is present in the Court, states that the petitioner undertakes to clear the outstanding loan amount in five equal installments on or before 31.03.2019, positively. He undertakes not to seek any further extension of time in making the payment.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5 points out that an amount of ₹4,80,546/- is outstanding against the petitioner.

In view of the undertaking so given by learned counsel for the petitioner, of course on the basis of instructions of his client, the present petition is hereby disposed of at this stage. He shall make payment of outstanding dues in five equal installments on or before 31.03.2019 along with admissible interest as agreed between the parties.

It is made clear that in case the petitioner fails to make the payment of outstanding amount or in default of any installments so agreed, the respondent No.5 shall be at liberty to take possession of the vehicle in question.
