With the sincere efforts of learned counsel for the appellant, a settlement in this case has been arrived at. Learned counsel for respondent No. 3-National Insurance Co. Ltd. has gracefully accepted to grant ₹ 14,000 (Rupees Fourteen Thousand only) over and above the amount granted by learned M.A.C.T. This amount is acceptable to appellant- Panno Devi as full and final settlement. Learned counsels for both the parties have signed the settlement.

In view of the above amicable settlement between the parties, we direct respondent No.3-National Insurance Co. Ltd., to deposit cheque or demand draft for ₹ 14,000 (Rupees Fourteen Thousand only) in favour of appellant- Panno Devi with the office of Lok Adalat of the High Court. The payment as agreed to be paid to the appellant- Panno Devi within a period of two months failing which the amount shall carry 9% interest per annum from the date of settlement.
