The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.73 dated 18.09.2012, registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 and 336 IPC (in which the police has filed challan under Sections 323, 324, 341, 336, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to order dated 05.02.2018 (passed in connected case i.e. CRM-M-15219-2017), report dated 06.03.2018 has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla, according to which, the statements of the parties have been recorded and the compromise is genuine and has been arrived at between them without any pressure or coercion.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and FIR No.73 dated 18.09.2012, registered at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 and 336 IPC (in which the police has filed challan under Sections 323, 324, 341, 336, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959) alongwith all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner.
