This petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 118 dated 20.12.2017 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that the matter has been settled between the parties in the Mediation and Conciliation of this Court on 16.4.2018. Further, learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Sikinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation, in terms of order dated 21.2.2018, and is no longer required.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the interim protection granted to the petitioner by order dated 21.2.2018 is made absolute.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by order dated 21.2.2018, the petitioner had been directed to deposit ₹20,000/- as litigation expenses. The same amount had already been released in favour of the complainant. However, her name has been mentioned on the cheque as “Harminderjit Kaur”, whereas her name, as reflected in her Aadhar Card and Passport is “Haninderjit Kaur”.

In view of the above fact, the petitioner is directed to return the cheque to the Registry, which in turn, shall issue a fresh cheque in the name of “Haninderjit Kaur”.

The petition stands disposed of.
