Pursuant to the notice issued in this petition on 21.02.2018, learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in Court to assist her, submits that the police visited the house of respondents no.4 to 6, who are stated to be the parents and brother of petitioner no.1, and recorded the statements of respondents no.4 and 6, i.e. father and brother of the said petitioner, to the effect that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners with each other, both being above the legally marriageable age.

Consequently, without making any comment on the validity of the marriage or otherwise, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners continue to be protected within the four corners of law.
