The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 16 dated 13.12.2017, registered under Sections 21, 29, 61, 85 of the NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 14 of the Foreigners Act, 1946 at Police Station STF Phase-4, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that co-accused of the petitioner namely John has been granted regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 06.03.2018, thus, the petitioner is also entitled for regular bail on the principle of parity.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that aforementioned John is co-accused in this case and his role is identical to that of the petitioner.

I have gone through the order dated 06.03.2018, passed in CRM-M-8503-2018 and I agree with the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned in terms of order dated 06.03.2018, passed in CRM-M-8503-2018.
