This is a revision petition against the impugned order dated 17.3.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Ludhiana vide which the petitioners were summoned to face trial under Sections 325, 323, 341 read with Sections 148, 149 Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners are specifically named in the FIR and a role has also been attributed to them. It is alleged that all the assailants came together and formed an unlawful assembly and inflicted injuries on the person of the complainant party.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court is of the opinion that the impugned order does not suffer from any illegality, irregularity and infirmity.

Dismissed.
