Petitioner-Amandeep Singh @ Amna has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.154 dated 07.11.2017, registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala, under Sections 399 and 402 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the basis of secret information to the effect that petitioner along with six co-accused has formed a gang. They were armed with illegal weapons and trying to rob the petrol pump and liquor vends. Thereafter, the raid was conducted. However, the present petitioner was not arrested during the raid, but was arrested later on. It is stated that pistol was recovered from the present petitioner on 11.12.2017.

The petitioner has been in custody since 11.12.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
