This petition for regular bail has been filed by petitioner – Bikramjit Singh @ Bikram Singh – an accused in FIR No.113 dated 18.7.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 452, 326, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar.

Shortly put, the facts of the case as per prosecution story are that on 17.7.2017 at about 9:00/9:30 p.m. Satnam Singh armed

with a *kahi* (spade), his son Bikram Jit Singh alias Bikram armed with a *kirpan* (sword) (present petitioner), Jagdeep Singh and Nirmal Singh @ Sonu sons of Gurvail Singh armed with *datars*, Rajanpreet Singh @ Raja son of Satnam Singh armed with a *kirch* trespassed in the house of complainant Kewal Singh, a brother of accused Satnam Singh situated at village Kohali and on an exhortation being raised by Satnam Singh, Jagdeep Singh gave a *datar* blow hitting Gurjant Singh son of complainant Kewal Singh on his head, Nirmal Singh gave a *datar* blow hitting Gurjant Singh on his left arm, Bikramjit Singh gave a *kirpan* blow hitting Sajjanpreet Singh another son of complainant on his left wrist; that when complainant stepped forward to save his sons, then Rajanpreet Singh @ Raja gave a *kirch* blow hitting the index finger of right hand of complainant; that when complainant raised hue and cry, all the accused ran away from the spot along with their respective weapons. The injured were hospitalized. The matter was reported to the police. Petitioner was arrested in this case on 21.7.2017 and he is in custody since then. The accused have been challaned and the trial is going on. The petitioner – accused – Bikramjit Singh @ Bikram Singh had moved an application for regular bail in Court of Sessions at Amritsar but was unsuccessful and the same was dismissed vide order dated 17.11.2017 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar. As such, he has approached this Court craving for similar relief by

filing of the present petition, which is being resisted by learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties besides going through the record.

Here the injury attributed to the petitioner is grievous in nature caused with a KIRPAN. Though one of the co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Rajanpreet Singh @ Raja was granted regular bail by this Court but it was for the reason that injury attributed to him was on non vital part. Here the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the wrist which is a vital part of the body. Therefore, the petitioner is not entitled for grant of regular bail. The trial is going on and is likely to be completed shortly.

Therefore, finding no merit in the petition, the same stands dismissed.
