Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.169 dated 19.08.2017, registered under Sections 364, 323, 341, 342, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Kotwali, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of order dated 22.02.2018 of this court and nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. No specific role has been attributed to him and no more required for his custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 22.02.2018, passed by this court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
