Pursuant to the order dated 09.07.2018, petitioner-Shingara Singh is present in Court today. With reference to conviction order dated 17.9.2015 under Sections 279, 304-A, 427 IPC, petitioner is stated to have approached the Legal Service Authority for filing Criminal Revision before this Court having regard to his financial status. While the Legal Service Authority took up the matter, it is under process. Simultaneously, petitioner approached Advocate Shri P.S. Sekhon for filing Criminal Revision against the order of conviction dated 17.9.2015. Before Legal Service Authority filing Criminal Revision, Shri. P.S. Sekhon, Advocate has filed Criminal Revision which was numbered as CRR-1464-2017. Thereafter, Legal Service Authority has also filed Criminal Revision in this Court which is numbered as CRR-2386-2017. Neither the petitioner nor the State counsel have pointed out to this Court while deciding CRR-2386 of 2017 on 15.11.2017 to the extent that petitioner has filed another CRR-1464-2017 against conviction order dated 17.9.2015. On 15.11.2017, CRR-2386-2017 has been decided while affirming the judgments of both the courts below and conviction order. In this background, CRR-1464-2017 do not survive

for consideration irrespective whether petitioner has presented CRR-1464-2017 earlier than the CRR-2386-2017. Two CRR arising out of the same judgment/order are listed before this Court independently due to lapse on the part of the Registry of this Court.

2. In view of the aforesaid development, CRR-1464-2017 do not survive for consideration having regard to the disposal of CRR-2386-2017 on 15.11.2017.

3. Accordingly, petition stands dismissed. Copy of this order be conveyed to the Court below for further action in the matter.
