The petitioners pray for issuing directions for speedy decision of the application dated 24.10.2017 filed before JMIC, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur for release of their passports.

The contention is that the petitioners, who are citizens of the United States of America, had sought anticipatory bail in complaint No. 199/19.05.2014/16.11.2016 *Amrik Singh vs. Manjit Singh and others* under Sections 452/323/324/341/427/506/34 IPC. The anticipatory bail was granted subject to deposit of their passports. Thereafter, the petitioners have been discharged by the trial Court and, therefore, an application was moved for return of their passports.

Although an application was filed on 24.10.2017, the same has not been decided till date.

In view of the nature and the relief sought, there is no requirement for issuing notice of motion.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with direction to Ms. Tushar Kaur Thind, JMIC, Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur to decide the application dated 24.10.2017 within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
