The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.161 dated 08.05.2016, registered under Sections 148, 149, 120-B & 302 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and under Section 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Sonipat.

2. In compliance of the order passed on 01.03.2018, it is fairly submitted on behalf of the State that there is no direct independent material to establish presence of the vehicle recovered at the instance of the petitioner near the place of occurrence on the relevant date.
