This petition has been filed challenging order dated 20.03.2017.

The learned Additional Sessions Judge, Narnaul on 20.03.2017 while finding a prima case under Sections 354A/354D, 506 IPC and Section 3 of The Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act ('SC/ST Act' – for short) against the petitioner framed charges, accordingly. The petitioner was primarily aggrieved of framing of charge under Section 3 of the SC/ST Act.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 submits that the trial, in this case, is almost over. The entire evidence has been led and the matter is listed for final arguments on 02.05.2018 before the learned trial Court.

Keeping in view the stage of the trial, I do not find it expedient to interfere at this stage.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed.
