The instant revision petition has been filed against the order and judgment dated 29.09.2014 passed by the Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ajnala vide which the accused/respondents have been acquitted in FIR No.41 dated 19.02.2008 under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar and this revision is also against the judgment dated 26.11.2015 passed by the Court of Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar, vide which appeal filed by the State of Punjab against aforesaid judgment of acquittal has also been dismissed.

Aggrieved against both orders, the complainant has preferred the instant criminal revision petition.

On the last date of hearing, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court took note of the fact that there was no representation on behalf of the

petitioner and last opportunity was afforded to the petitioner to address arguments.

On perusal of the case file it is found that on most of the hearings either the counsel for the petitioner was not present or has been seeking adjournments through proxy.

The case is listed for today and it is around 2.45 p.m. and there is no representation even today on behalf of the petitioner and it seems that the petitioner is no more interested to pursue the case.

Therefore, the present criminal revision is dismissed for non-prosecution.
