The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.1284, dated 17.12.2017, registered under Section 323, 324, 24, 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Karnal City, District Karnal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had also submitted a complaint against the complainant in which it was alleged that the complainant side was the aggressor and that the injury was caused accidentally by the companion of the complainant although the knife was directed at the petitioner. Thus, the submission is that at this stage it cannot be stated with any amount of certainty that the petitioner caused the alleged injury. He further submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 20.12.2017. The

investigation is complete and challan has already been presented and therefore, there is no likelihood of the petitioner interfering with the investigation.

3. Learned State counsel however, submits that as per MLR, the injury is grievous in nature and therefore, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of regular bail.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, I deem it just and appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner on the ground that the investigation is complete and challan has already been presented in the Court and that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody indefinitely.

5. In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the petitioner- Bijender Kumar son of Shri Prem Rao, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, concerned at Karnal.
