Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.20 dated 27.11.2015 (Annexure P-1), registered under Section 67A of the Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Punjab State Cyber Crime, SAS Nagar, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise dated 16.02.2018 (Annexure P-2).

This Court by order dated 28.02.2018, directed the parties to appear before the Court below for recording their respective statements.

Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar Mohali, has submitted report dated 13.04.2018, where the complainant stated that he is not ready to compromise the matter with the petitioner as the terms and conditions of the settlement between the parties having not been complied with by the accused. Chief Judicial Magistrate, SAS Nagar Mohali, has thus concluded that the compromise between the parties has not been effected.

In view of the above report, there being no compromise

between the parties, the present petition cannot be allowed and this explains the non-appearance of counsel for the petitioner as well.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
