Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 26 dated 06.04.2017, registered under Sections 452, 307, 323, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Banur, District Patiala.

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was arrested on 14.11.2017 and since then he is in custody. His submission is that present is the case of no injury and the petitioner has been falsely implicated and the recovery of country made pistol is from the co-accused Harjinder Singh. No role has been attributed to the petitioner except that he being present at the spot and entered the house of the complainant and gave a slap. He contends that the challan has been presented and charge till date has not been framed. The trial is not likely to conclude in near future and therefore prays that the present petition be

allowed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, informs the Court that the next date of hearing before the trial Court is 02.04.2018.

In the light of the statement made by learned counsel for the State and keeping in view the allegations against the petitioner as also the fact that the charge has not been framed till date with a case being of no injury, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
