Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 13.08.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation. Co-accused Ravi has been released on anticipatory bail and the order granting anticipatory bail has also been made absolute.

Learned State counsel also affirms the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, however, he opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that the case of the petitioner is not at par with co-accused Ravi.

Since the petitioner has joined investigation, co-accused has been released on bail and the allegations in the FIR are matter of evidence

which shall be considered by the trial Court during trial, interim order dated 23.02.2018 passed by this Court in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.
