The petitioner prays for issuing directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect his life and liberty and that of his family, which is allegedly threatened at the hands of respondent No. 4.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondent No. 4 at this stage.

The allegation is that although no criminal case is registered against the petitioner, he is being harassed by respondent No. 4.

The petitioner has submitted representations dated 04.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) and 02.02.2018 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No. 3.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 3 to look into the allegations made in the said representations and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
