This is a petition that has been filed seeking to renew the passport as well as permission to travel abroad in the month of March.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The dispute has arisen between the petitioner and complainant-Urvashi Chopra. The matter was compromised amongst themselves and thereafter a divorce was also obtained. The petitioner herein has paid a sum of ₹ 16,24,700/- to Urvashi Chopra in terms of the compromise and has also filed a petition thereafter for quashing of the FIR. However, dispute arose with the complainant-Urvashi Chopra raising the claim of ₹ 1,24,700/- as the same is yet to be paid to her. This Court has heard the matter and reserved judgment.

Since there is an urgency in the matter. This petition is taken up for hearing after issuing notice to the respondent-State.

The lis between the parties already stands compromised and settled, with a decree of divorce having been obtained. The petitioner herein is permitted to travel abroad for a period from 17.03.2018 to 22.03.2018.

The petitioner is also permitted to approach the Regional Passport Authority for renewal of his passport in accordance with law.

This petition stand disposed of.
