Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 305, dated 13.11.2017 under Sections 307, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sahlawas, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in judicial lock up since 14.11.2017; investigation is complete and challan under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted before the trial Court by deleting Section 307 and adding Section 326 IPC. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has also suffered injury and the marriage between the petitioner and the injured i.e. his wife is about 28 years old.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is no more required for further custodial investigation; he is in judicial lock up since 14.11.2017; the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate; the conclusion of the trial will take long

time for disposal of the same as charges are yet to be framed, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate.
