Learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the instant petition at this stage, but he prays that trial Court may be directed to expedite the trial.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

However, as the petitioner has been in custody since long, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments or even by adjourning the case on day to day basis, if necessary. Investigating Officer/Station House Officer of the concerned police station is directed to produce the remaining witnesses on the next two-three dates before the trial Court. SSP, Tarn Taran is also directed to look into the matter personally and ensure that the witnesses be produced before the trial Court at the earliest.
