Learned State Counsel on instructions from SI Karanjit Singh states that FSL report has not been received so far. Petitioner is a lady. 800 tablets of microlit were allegedly recovered from the petitioner.

In view of ratio laid down in ***Inderjit Singh @ Laddi and others Vs. State of Punjab, 2014(3) RCR (Criminal) 953,*** let the petitioner be granted interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court with a clear stipulation that in the event of receiving positive FSL report, the petitioner shall surrender

before the trial Court within reasonable time to be specified by the trial Court.
