This revision petition has been filed against order dated 30.03.2017 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Sangrur vide which application filed by the petitioner under Section 319 Cr.P.C. was dismissed for summoning Surinder Singh alias Soni, son of Thenedar and Gursagar Singh alias Sagar as additional accused in the FIR.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 has put in appearance and submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous since the main accused has been acquitted vide order dated 10.01.2018. The Sessions Judge, Sangrur on discussing the evidence that had been led, came to the conclusion that the basis of the FIR is falsified from the cross-examination of the victim namely PW-2 while further concluding that the medical report

also did not substantiate the claim of the prosecution.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 28.03.2018, there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was listed on 24.07.2018 and thereafter adjourned to 12.11.2018. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the main accused has already been acquitted by a detailed and reasoned judgment, no further orders are called for.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly, leaving it open to the petitioner to re-agitate his claim, should the need so arise.
