This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.214 dated 9.10.2017 under sections 323, 341, 325, 336, 379-B, 506, 148, 149 I.P.C and sections 27, 25, 54 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Dharamkot, District Moga.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Kashmir Singh in relation to an alleged occurrence dated 29.9.2017. Allegations are that the complainant Kashmir Singh was physically assaulted and caused injuries by a number of accused including the present petitioner.

During the course of arguments today, it has gone uncontroverted that the injury suffered by complainant on his right arm/wrist attracting offence under section 325 I.P.C has been specifically attributed to Mittal Mal @ Mita (non-applicant).

In so far as the present petitioner is concerned, allegation is of having raised a *lalkara*.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Malkit Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

In the considered view of this Court, custodial interrogation of the petitioner, as such, would not be warranted. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 12.3.2018, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
