Learned State counsel submits that petitioner No.1-Vishal Parbhakar has not joined the investigation despite a specific direction issued, though petitioners No.2 and 3, namely, Vikas Parbhakar and Vivek Parbhakar has joined the investigation. No plausible explanation could be given for petitioner No.1-Vishal Parbhakar not joining the investigation, therefore, the petition for pre-arrest bail qua him stands dismissed.

Petitioners No.2 and 3 are stated to have joined the investigation and as stated by the State counsel, on instructions from ASI Salwan Singh, Police Station Chheharta, Amritsar City, since the matter has been compromised between the parties, custodial interrogation of petitioners is not required. Therefore, interim bail granted to petitioners No.2 and 3, namely, Vikas Parbhakar and Vivek Parbhakar vide order dated 11.01.2018 passed by this Court, is made absolute, subject to fulfilment of conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C., whereas same stands dismissed as regards petitioner No.1-Vishal Parbhakar.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
