Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 112 dated 23.7.2014, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 379, 427, 506, 447, 448, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana City District Ludhiana.

On 26.2.2018, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is son of the complainant. Complainant starting living in live-in relationship with Ranjit Kaur. In respect of share of the petitioner in the property, there was a compromise before the police which was not adhered to in respect of buying of 100

sq. yards plot for the petitioner. FIR was registered on 23.07.2014 and thereafter, petitioner was allowed to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 18.04.2018.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 04.03.2018 and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Tarsem Singh, submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 4.3.2018 and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of above, order dated 26.02.2018 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
