Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for directing respondents No.2 to 4 to investigate the complaint filed by the petitioner properly, which was closed by respondent No.3 vide order dated 18.07.2017 and take appropriate action against respondents No.5 to 8.

Earlier also, the petitioner moved a similar petition bearing No.CRM-M-18962-2017, which was disposed of vide order dated 02.06.2017 as having rendered infructuous.

In fact, the petitioner is a co-sharer in joint holding. He wishes that his share should be separated from other co-sharers by putting undue pressure of police upon them, which is not permissible in law. The petitioner should file a suit for partition against his co-sharers to get his share partitioned. He cannot be permitted to adopt shortcut method to coerce his co-sharers for the said purpose. Necessary protection for his life and liberty has already been granted to the petitioner vide order dated 02.06.2017 passed in CRM-M-18962-2017.

The petition, being meritless, is dismissed.
