Pursuant to the notice issued in this petition on 23.02.2018, in which the petitioners sought protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of respondents no.4 and 5, who are stated to be parents of petitioner no.2, on account of the fact that they have married each other of their own free will, against the wishes of the said respondents, learned State counsel has filed in Court today an affidavit of Sh. Mukesh Kumar, HPS, DSP, Headquarters, Sonapat, to the effect that the date of birth of petitioner no.2 is 01.02.1998, which has been verified from the school she last studied.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents no.4 and 5, i.e. the parents of petitioner no.2, submits that the said respondents have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners with each other.

Consequently, without making any comment on the validity of the marriage, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents no.2

and 3 to ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners, continue to be protected, within the four corners of law.
