Petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the respondents in the context of injuries suffered by his son in the manner as disclosed in the statement dated 16.07.2017 made by the petitioner before the police.

According to learned counsel for the petitioner, inquiry was conducted by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Mohali and he has recommended lodging of FIR against the culprits. Thereafter, one more inquiry has been ordered to be initiated. The grievance of the petitioner is that the police wants to drop the proceedings under the garb of initiation of second inquiry.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, petitioner has moved a representation before respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Let requisite copies of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon any reply from the respondents.

At this stage, this petition can be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the representation (Annexure P3) dated 10.10.2017 made by the petitioner and act in accordance with law without being influenced by any statement of facts recorded hereinabove.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
