This is a petition seeking to challenge the interim maintenance that was allowed to the petitioners as being inadequate. The petitioners herein i.e. the wife and the minor children were awarded a sum of Rs.1500/- per month as interim maintenance.

By an order dated 16.07.2018, learned counsel for the respondent herein submits that in the integrum the main petition itself stands dismissed in default and, therefore, prays for the dismissal of the present petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the respondent and also perused the order dated 16.07.2018 whereby the application for grant of maintenance under Section 125 Cr.P.C. stands dismissed.

In view of the said order, the instant petition is not

maintainable.

However, before parting with this order, the liberty is given to the petitioners to have these proceedings revived in case the order dated 16.07.2018 is set aside.
