In the instant petition, petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.211 dated 01.10.2017 under Sections 323/34/506 IPC Section 325 IPC added subsequently registered at Police Station Ateli, District Mahendergarh (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise Annexure P-2 arrived at between the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that FIR is an outcome of a sudden quarrel and now has been resolved. The injuries are on non-vital parts of the body of complainant and sought for quashing of FIR in view of compromise.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel submitted on the basis of reply dated 24.04.2018 that the FIR can be quashed on the basis of compromise keeping in view the nature of offence.

4. This Court by the order dated 26.02.2018 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for recording their

statements with regard to veracity of the compromise. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Narnaul has sent her report dated 23.03.2018 wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded and compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

In view of the law laid down in “*Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab*” 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.211 dated 01.10.2017 under Sections 323/34/506 IPC Section 325 IPC added subsequently registered at Police Station Ateli, District Mahendergarh (Annexure P-1) all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed against the petitioners subject to payment of litigation cost of Rs.5000/- by each of the petitioner to State of Haryana. Cost shall be remitted in the Treasury, State of Haryana within a period of 3 months from today.
