The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in FIR No.54, dated 01.09.2017, under Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, and Section 436 IPC, registered at Police Station GRP-Ferozepur, District Govt. Railway Police Ferozepur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the FIR as well as in the examination-in-chief during trial and stated that the petitioner was not present at the place of the incident and no damage was caused to the Railway Station. However, it is submitted that the petitioner has been in custody for five months and nineteen days and the investigation is complete, therefore, he may be granted regular bail

3. Learned State counsel is not in a position to controvert the above factual averments.

4. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner-Pardeep Kumar @ Nita, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court concerned at Ferozepur.
