This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.32 dated 06.03.2014, under Sections 304A and 279 of the IPC a registered at Police Station Division No. 7 (Vardhman), Ludhiana City, Punjab.

[2]. The petitioner was originally on bail but absented from the proceedings on account of which coercive processes were issued against him. His justification for not attending the Court is that he was under a misconception that the matter had been terminated following the compromise he otherwise had entered into the victim's family.

[3]. He was however arrested on the strength of the pending processes against him on 04.01.2018, and has thereafter remained in detention.

[4] In the given circumstances and considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, particularly when the offences in the case are of bailable nature, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/

Duty Magistrate, concerned.
