[1]. Notice of motion.

[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let a copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioner prays for being released on bail after the warrant of arrest was ordered to be issued against him on 01.02.2018, on which date, the case was fixed for consideration of charge.

[4]. The petitioner's justification for his absence as made out in Paragraph No.7 of the petition is that due to indisposition he was unable to attend the Court on the relevant date, and has shown his original Medical Certificate in support of this contention.

[5]. It transpires that the matter is now listed before both the Ld. Trial Court on 08.03.2018.

[6]. In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the
