The petitioner prays for issuing directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect his life and liberty and that of his family, which is allegedly endangered by respondent No. 5.

The allegations are that respondent No. 5 who is incharge of Special Task Force, Tarn Taran is threatening the petitioner and his family and harassing them on account of political affiliations of the petitioner. It is alleged that on 06.02.2018 at about 11.00. p.m. respondent No. 5 came to the house of the petitioner in plain clothes alongwith 20-25 persons and ransack the house. Number of items were picked up apart from cash and jewellery. Despite repeated representations, the police is not taking any action against the said respondents.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amandeep S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Let five copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondent No. 5 at this stage.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No. 2 to look into the allegations made in the representation dated 15.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law, if any is necessitated.
