The petitioner having time and again not appeared before the trial Court after he was granted bail, and even after costs of Rs.10,000/- imposed upon him he yet again made another application for exemption from appearance citing medical reasons, with no medical record to support it.

Consequently, I find absolutely no ground to grant the petitioner the concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.

However, upon the petitioner surrendering before the learned trial Court and moving an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C., that would be considered by that Court on its own merits and decided expeditiously.
