The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.27 dated 04.06.2017 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act at police station Kotli Surat Mallian, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that during investigation the petitioners were declared innocent and they have joined the proceedings and surrendered before learned Trial Court on 13.02.2018 and co-accused have already been released on bail.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel on instructions from SHO/SI Avtar Singh.

It is very strange that despite the fact that the petitioners surrendered on 13.02.2018, but the police is not aware about this fact and learned State counsel has pointed out that in this regard inquiry is

being conducted.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars any more. Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is accepted. Petitioners- Arunpreet Singh and Ankurdeep Singh be admitted to bail on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

Petitions stands disposed of.
