For the reasons mentioned in the application, delay of 478 days in filing the present revision is condoned.

CRM-18497-2017

This is an application filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure for interim release of vehicle of the petitioner bearing registration No.RJ-04-G-1761 in FIR No.96 dated 30.07.2014, under Sections 15/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar, Moga.

The truck was taken into custody in abovesaid FIR. Petitioner is stated to be owner of the said vehicle. He moved an application for release of truck but it was declined solely on the ground that the main accused Manjit Singh, who is son of the petitioner, has been declared proclaimed offender. However, now he has surrendered before the trial court.

To the mind of this court, truck is no more required in this case. As such, it is ordered that the same be released to its registered owner against proper receipt and identification and subject to the conditions imposed by the trial court.

Disposed of accordingly.

In view of order passed in *CRM-18497-2017*, petition is allowed and impugned order dated 05.11.2015 stands *set aside*.
