This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.214, dated 03.12.2017 registered at Police Station Khizrabad, District Yamuna Nagar under Sections 186, 353, 379 IPC and Section 21(4)(1) of the Mines Act, 1952.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance with the order dated 27.02.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for the said purpose.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ishwar Chander, Police Station Khijrabad, does not dispute this fact. He further submits that as of now the petitioner is not required for any purposes.

In this view of the matter, order dated 27.02.2018 is made absolute. The petitioner shall, however, bound by the provisions as contained under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
