Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.84 dated 30.10.2012, under Section 188 IPC and later on added Section 21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, registered at Police Station Ghaga, District Patiala.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner had earlier been granted bail. However, on account of having misused the concession and having not appeared before the trial Court, the concession of bail was cancelled and bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State.

After following due procedure, petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender vide order dated 04.11.2017 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Samana. Such order concededly is not under challenge.

The conduct of the petitioner dis-entitles him from the concession of pre arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
