Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sandeep Singh, states that the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed offender and after his arrest, supplementary challan has been filed against him and during trial, out of 8 prosecution witnesses cited, 6 have been examined, with next date of hearing being 29.08.2018. That means, the trial is going to be concluded in near future.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time states that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition, though a direction be given to the trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.

Allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy

of the order there by giving short adjournments and State shall ensure the appearance of the remaining PWs on the date fixed before the trial Court.
