This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.96, dated 18.10.2016 registered at Police Station Division No.6, Jalandhar District Jalandhar under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 & 120 B IPC.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance with the order dated 27.02.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for the said purpose.

Counsel for the State does not dispute this fact. He further submits that as of now the petitioner is not required for any purposes.
