The petitioner having been in custody for 3 years, 8 months and 4 day, as per the custody certificate filed in Court today by the learned State counsel, though learned State counsel and the complainant oppose him being released on bail on the ground that he is the person at whose instance the occurrence took place, he allegedly having been in possession of Panchayat land which was got vacated allegedly at the instance of the complainant and those on his side; however, in view of the fact that the trial is nowhere near conclusion, with the specific role attributed to the petitioner being exhortation, without making any comment whatsoever on the actual involvement of the petitioner in the occurrence (or not), which would be naturally seen by the trial Court in terms of the evidence led before it,

I consider it appropriate to admit him to bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
