In this petition, the petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case F.I.R. No.7, dated 15.01.2018, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 379-B and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Rampura (Rewari).

2. Seen the Police Diary, including injuries suffered by the victims.
3. Admittedly, the same were caused only by blunt objects.
4. There is no direct allegation against petitioner of having snatched anything from the complainant in the F.I.R.
5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely Parveen son of Rajender, shall be released on

anticipatory bail by the Arresting/Investigating Officer subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
