Petitioner prays, in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect her life and liberty which is allegedly threatened by respondents No. 4 to 10 and for further directions to register an FIR against the said respondents.

According to the petitioner, who is Sarpanch of Village Jharli, Tehsil and District Jhajjar, one park i.e. Dr. B.R.Ambedkar Park is being developed in the village but respondents No.4 to 10 are interfering in its development and are physically assaulting the workmen, who are engaged in the process. In this regard, one MLR dated 23.10.2017 (Annexure P-5) relating to injuries caused to driver of the JCB has been placed on record. A representation dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure P-6) has been made in this regard but no action is being taken thereupon.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pardeep Sharma, learned AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order being passed, it is not necessary to call upon respondents No. 4 to 10 at this stage. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of

with directions to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, to enquire into the allegations made in representation dated 30.10.2017 (Annexure P-6) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, in case the same is necessitated. The same be done within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
