Petitioner has approached this Court praying for setting aside the order passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hisar, whereby the petitioner was convicted and sentenced on 31.01.2013 to pay a sum of Rs. 1 lac to the complainant within a period of one year from the order, failing which he was liable to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one year and the appeal, which was preferred by the petitioner, stands dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar on 13.09.2016.

When the case came up for hearing before this Court, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. where the matter has been amicably resolved and a settlement/agreement was entered into between the parties on 08.03.2018.

Counsel for the parties submit that in the light of the settlement/agreement dated 08.03.2018, the parties having put to an end their dispute, the present revision petition may be disposed of by observing that the matter has been amicably resolved and settled.

Keeping in view the statement of the counsel for the parties, who have asserted that the matter stands settled, the offence is hereby compounded.

In view of the above, the present revision petition is allowed and the conviction and sentence of the petitioner is set aside.
